Holmdel School District Employees to Receive COVID-19 Vaccines

(Holmdel, NJ - March 12, 2021): The Holmdel Board of Education announced that it has partnered with the [Visiting Nurses Association of New Jersey](#) to implement a program to offer COVID-19 vaccinations to all educators, administrators, and staff in the District.

The District's program began on March 8th and vaccinations are offered at multiple off-site locations in Monmouth County, including Bell Works in Holmdel.

To date, 150 members of the School District have signed up for the program and over 40 staff members have already received the vaccine and another 50 members are scheduled to receive the vaccine on Monday.

“As part of our school district's reopening plan, we made it a priority to find a way to offer the COVID-19 vaccine to the educators, administrators, and staff who want it, and to get it to them as quickly and as efficiently as possible,” says Interim Superintendent Dr. Lee Seitz. “The partnership with the Visiting Nurses of New Jersey provides our District with just that opportunity.”

“We are thrilled that our teachers, administrators and support staff are taking advantage of this opportunity to get vaccinated. The willingness of our colleagues to get vaccinated is another significant step to protect the health of our staff as we battle the pandemic, added Seitz.”
