- West Common server sanitary pipe completely rusted through (will replace section of pipe from wrestling locker room through server to student activities office)

East Building Addition Update

- Construction drawings are 75% complete
- Final drawings for first bid package are due 7/11
- Board scheduled to approve at 8/21 Board meeting (includes site work, foundation, steel and underground utilities)
- Final drawings for the second bid package due in August
- Board approve the second & final bid package at the 10/16 Board meeting (includes remaining trades)
- Illinois clean energy foundation grant submitted on 6/15; will be announced in July

Summer 2018 Construction Planning

Discussions focused on projects such as the Fieldhouse vestibule, Transition house repurpose, Data processing moving to room 7096, Little Pats moving to 6000 suite, East building roof, Port Clinton entrance, converting existing Little Pats space, Literacy coaches office, West Building dance office room 2010, Mezzanine dance room, Percussion breakout room, Orchestra storage, Midi lab renovation, Choir storage, tuckpointing, LED lighting conversion, ceiling tile replacement, window replacement and planting.

Recommendation: Authorize Wight & Co. to move to design develop phase.

Long-Term Mechanical Planning

Discussions focused on the master plan, units needing repair, Siemens, Sodexo, Gilbane & Wight's review, performance contract amendment, budget, District Office HVAC and upcoming larger projects.

<u>Recommendation</u>: Authorize the continued discussion with Siemens on a performance contract amendment.
