

## Options for Driver's Education

### **Option 1      Cost is \$80**

Take the Driver's Education course at Layton High School as part of the high school schedule for a semester.

\*student MUST have the learner's permit before first day of class

\*student earns .50 elective credit

### **Option 2      Cost is \$140**

Take a summer class (student earns .25 elective credit)

\*Payment must be made in the Layton High School main office starting April 10<sup>th</sup>

\*After April 14<sup>th</sup>, registration will be open for students from other high schools

\*Must show Learner's permit to enroll in class

Summer Sessions (7:30 am – 10:30 am, Mon-Fri)

June 7-17, 2021, Final test on June 18th

July 6-16, 2021, Final test on July 19th

July 26 – August 5, 2021, Final test on August 6th

Students cannot miss a day or leave early for any reason. If this happens, it's an automatic fail for the class and money cannot be refunded. These rules apply to meet state law requiring 27 hours of classroom time. Driving time will happen soon after class is completed. If there is a conflict, please contact Scott Applegate ahead of time.

### **Option 3      Class is free, Driving fee is \$80**

Online class through Davis Connect (free during the school year, 46.50 in summer)

\*Student must see a counselor to sign up then contacts a driver's ed. Teacher to arrange driving

\*Student earns .25 elective credit

Parent arranges for private instruction.
