

## COURSE SELECTION PROCESS - 2021– 2022

### Student's Role in the Process

- ✓ Go to the CCHS website for Academic Course Guide and all other information and forms associated with Course Selections. (Posted to the website on March 17<sup>th</sup>)
- ✓ Review 2021 - 2022 CCHS Academic Course Guide.
  - Course guide provides the requirements for each course offered.
  - Students must meet the requirements listed for the course.
  - Students select courses based on the current course average reported in the academic portal.
- ✓ Select six (6) core courses
  - Students/parents review graduation requirements.
  - Every student must take 1 Religion, 1 English and 1 Math course each year.
  - Freshmen, sophomores and juniors must also take 1 science and 1 social studies course.
  - Every student must take at least 2 years of a World Language.
  - Freshmen and sophomores take a 7<sup>th</sup> class to complete the Fine & Performing Arts or Programming requirement.
- ✓ Juniors and Seniors - If you wish to participate in the **Plus-One Program (POP)**.
  - A "POP" course is a course that class is **in addition to** the student's 6 core courses. A POP class does not allow time for study halls in a student's daily schedule.
    - Students who wish to enroll in a "POP" class must:
      1. Have a Career AGPA of a 3.3 or better.
      2. Fill out an application for a "POP" class.
      3. Attach the "POP" application to the course selection form.
- ✓ **Return course selection forms to the box outside the Main Office or to the Counseling Office no later than the date designated for your year level.**
- ✓ Students who need assistance with course selections should contact their School Counselor for an appointment.
- ✓ Counselors will complete a final review of course selections (based on final averages) June 11<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> and notify students of any changes that have taken place.
