Goals:

- Layton Elementary will increase the percentage of K-3 students making typical or better growth on the Acadience Pathways-to-Progress MOY (middle of year) composite score from 57% in 2020-2021 to 62% in 2021-2022
- Layton Elementary will increase the percentage of our English Language Learner students making typical or better growth on the Acadience Pathways-to-Progress MOY composite score benchmark from 38% in 2020-2021 to 41% in 2021-2022.
- Layton Elementary will intentionally create and maintain an environment in which students’ diverse backgrounds, identities, strengths, and challenges are

acknowledged and respected using the 5 CASEL SEL competencies, indicators, and strategies along with Sustainable Development Goals. We expect student centered Social Emotional goals to support learners and learner proficiency as outlined in goals number 1 and 2.
