- Has a good understanding of K-12 budgets and state finances

- Has successful experiences working with labor groups

SELECTION PROCESS

The consultants will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. The Board will have the opportunity to review all applications submitted. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

THE DISTRICT

The Morgan Hill Unified School District comprises a diverse population, inhabiting a substantial, 300 square mile area in the southern region of Santa Clara County. Our 14 neighborhood schools are the heartbeat of our community, with each school providing a central destination for education, growth, and support on both an academic and social-emotional level. The District is currently the largest employer in the City of Morgan Hill, with approximately 800 employees in positions ranging from maintenance, bus drivers, office staff, teachers to administrators. In November of 2016 the school board transitioned from at-large to district elections in an effort to increase minority representation on the seven member MHUSD school board.

The District serves nearly 9,000 students within our six elementary schools, two elementary/middle schools, one dual immersion magnet program, one continuation high school, two comprehensive high schools, and one community adult school. Our schools are located mostly in Morgan Hill, but also San Martin and South San Jose. The District's minority enrollment is 69% of the student body with the majority being Latinx.

THE COMMUNITY

Morgan Hill is one of Silicon Valley's rare gems: a getaway destination that's both full of opportunity and easily accessible, just a short distance from downtown San Jose. It is home to an abundance of fresh air and rolling hills, award-winning wineries, an up-and-coming downtown with fabulous restaurants, art, and boutique shopping, world-class cycling and hiking routes, you-pick farms, state-of-the-art sporting facilities, gorgeous special event venues, championship golf courses, and heartwarming local festivals.
