Letter from the Director

13 August 2020

Dear Parents,

I hope the second half of the summer holiday with your children was safe and relaxing. I expect that your children are eager to return to school and start their learning adventures with their peers. With the 2020-2021 school year starting in two weeks, it is time to resume the school's weekly newsletter.

First, I want to let you know that my family and I arrived safely in Germany. We completed our quarantine and received the results of our COVID-19 tests (they were negative). After getting the family situated in our new home in Altenberge, I started to work on campus to become more familiar with the facilities and start preparing for the new school year.

Part of the preparation for the new year is creating an Opening Plan. I am currently finalizing the Opening Plan to make sure the necessary safety precautions expected from local authorities are implemented correctly on our campus. Providing a safe learning environment for your children is my highest priority.

What will be included in the Open Plan? Below are some of the key subjects that will be covered:

- Logistics and procedures for returning to face to face instruction on campus
- Expectations and framework for distance learning (in the event we are required to return
- Overall technology needs and educational platforms used

I will share the Opening Plan when it is completed.

The first day of school is August 27th and will be a half-day. School has a starting time of 8:15. However, with COVID-19, we will continue the staggered entrance model used in the spring. The staggered procedure and times may differ from the spring; I am still evaluating them to see if any changes need to be made. The staggered procedure and start time will be included in the Opening Plan.

Before school begins, we have an Open House scheduled on the calendar on August 26th. For new parents, the purpose of Open House is for the students to meet their teachers for the upcoming school year. Returning and new families are invited. This helps build the students' comfort level in knowing who their teacher will be while at the same time decreasing any anxiety the students may have about the first day of school. In addition, middle school and secondary students receive their school schedules at the Open House. This event is usually held in the classrooms. For safety reasons, we are unable to host large gatherings in the school. We are exploring different options for hosting the Open House so your child can meet the teacher. More details on the Open House will be shared in the next newsletter.

If your family is arriving in Germany after August 27th, please let me know. We understand that traveling during this time can be complicated and sometimes out of your control. If possible, we can arrange for some work to be assigned remotely so your child does not fall behind. But at this time, a formal distance learning program will not be in place.

I hope the information shared above helps you ease into the upcoming school year. Creating the safest environment for your child's education is my number one goal. I know some of the details shared indicate "more information to come". This is not because of any lack of preparation. It is because I am cautiously and actively preparing to receive your child for the new school year. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact me. I frequently check e-mail and am available for video conferences. I look forward to meeting parents and students in person! Enjoy the remainder of your summer.
