

Director's Letter

Dear QSI Families,

A big thanks to the Parent Support Group for organizing the Welcome Picnic. We were so lucky to have such great weather that allowed us to meet outside and enjoy each other's company.

I appreciate the responses to the 2021-2022 calendar survey from last week. Your feedback provides me with information to make any necessary adjustments. The survey did show that two areas could be adjusted on the 2021-2022 calendar. The first is having the winter holiday start on December 20th in 2021 (over 75% reply). The second is the school will aim to have Rosenontag off in 2022 (over 90% reply).

The next part of planning is for an upcoming event - Parent/Teacher Conferences. In Pre-COVID times, this day is usually scheduled in advance. For new QSI families, the identified day of Parent/Teacher Conferences is held during an entire school day; there is no school on this day to allow for teachers to meet with parents. To provide flexibility, the day was not scheduled on the calendar so the day could be built around the current needs of the school. Due to the expectation of having decreased visitors on the school campus, the Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held via video conference. The school is aiming to have Parent/Teacher conferences, please take this one question survey - <u>Click here for the survey</u> Once a day is identified, more details on the Parent/Teacher Conference schedule will be sent out later.

Connected to Parent/Teacher Conferences, please know you do not need to wait for a parent/teacher conference to meet with your child's teacher. During the school year, our teachers are available via e-mail, phone and Teams video conferences to discuss the needs of your child. If you feel a face to face meeting with the teacher is necessary, it is possible to arrange a meeting after school. We have identified a safe meeting room that is not connected to the cohort of student classrooms.

For parents connected to GNC, I met with Conny Beckmann and Captain Sascha Vishover this week. We had a great meeting regarding our school and school's academics and student life.

To support parents who need to pick up their child early for school, a new early departure form has been created. Our previous system required parents to come inside and complete an early departure sign-out form on paper. Because of the expectation of limited traffic in the building, the school has changed it to a digital form. The form is included in this newsletter and will remain here in future issues for easy reference.

Keeping Safe Curriculum



Next week the homeroom teachers will start including the Keeping Safe Curriculum in the weekly lessons. These are short lessons that educate children on how to keep themselves safe and who to ask for help in unsafe situations. This is a global curriculum that QSI uses at all campuses. Themes

The curriculum follows 2 main themes:

- we all have the right to be safe
- we can help ourselves to be safe by talking to people we trust.

Focus areas

The 2 themes are explored through 4 focus areas:

- the right to be safe
- relationships
- recognizing and reporting abuse
- protective strategies.
