- 2. Identify through melodic dictation:
  - a. major and minor keys
  - b. diatonic pitches
  - c. melodies with skips to any scale degree
  - d. altered pitches
  - e. simple and compound meters
- 3. Identify through harmonic dictation:
  - a. Outer voice movement of primary chords (I, IV, V)
  - b. Secondary chords (ii, vii°, iii, vi)
  - c. Major and minor keys
- 4. Sight sing in major and minor keys:
  - a. Diatonic pitches
  - b. Melodies with skips to any scale degree
  - c. Altered pitches
  - d. Simple and compound meter
- 5. Aurally and visually discriminate four part harmonies with:
  - a. Cadences
  - b. 6/4 chords
  - c. Non-chord tones
  - d. Secondary dominants
