Exit Expectations
High School Advanced Drawing and Painting

All exiting Advanced Drawing and Painting students should be able to do the following:

1. Use the Elements of Art and Principles of Design to create realistic and abstract images.
2. Use the artistic process to imagine, plan, and create dynamic compositions.
3. Use drawing and painting techniques to develop a personal voice and style.
4. Develop a person portfolio of original, non-plagiarized artwork.*
5. Use a variety of lines to create innovative sketches and final compositions.
6. Create the illusion of depth using placement, linear perspective, color, size, detail, and overlapping.
7. Create personal interpretations of a variety of genre including portraits, landscapes, still life works, representational and non- representational abstract works of art.
8. Use the Elements of Art and Principles of Design to analyze and understand historical movements and styles.
9. Find inspiration from historical works to communicate personal ideas.
10. Use Elements of Art and Principles of Design to formulate written and verbal assessments/critiques of personal artworks.
11. Use aesthetic criticism to assess and articulate ideas and formulate educated judgments.
