**Exit Expectations**  
**High School AP Studio Art: Drawing, 2-Dimensional, 3-Dimensional**

All exiting AP Studio students should be able to do the following:

1. Use the Elements of Art and Principles of Design to create innovative and dynamic compositions.
2. Document the artistic process for each work of art via a sketchbook or journal.
3. Create artworks which demonstrate a personal voice and style.
4. Be able to communicate their personal style in a variety of media.
5. Develop a personal portfolio of original, non-plagiarized artwork.\*
6. Create a set of work based on a particular theme, concentration, or an area of exploration.
7. Use the Elements of Art and Principles of Design to analyze and understand historical movements and styles.
8. Find inspiration from historical works to communicate personal ideas.
9. Use Elements of Art and Principles of Design to formulate written and verbal assessments/critiques of personal artworks.
10. Use aesthetic criticism to assess and articulate ideas and formulate educated judgments.
