High School Ceramics I

All exiting Ceramics I students should be able to do the following:

1. Demonstrate an understanding of the Elements of Art relative to 3-dimensional works:

3. Follow the artistic process to imagine, plan, and create a successful form.

4. Be able to identify the stages of clay: slip, plastic, leather hard, green ware, bisque ware, glaze ware.

5. Demonstrate an understanding of basic ceramic construction: pinch, coil, slab, score /slip, carving, and combined techniques.

6. Create functional pieces of pottery sculptural ceramic artworks.

7. Use the Elements of Art and Principle of Design to analyze and understand historical and cultural artworks.

8. Draw inspiration from historical/cultural works to communicate personal ideas.

9. Use Elements of Art and Principles of Design to formulate written and verbal assessments/critiques of personal artworks.
