Exit Expectations
High School Ceramics II

All exiting Ceramics II students should be able to do the following:

1. Demonstrate an understanding of the Elements of Art Principles of Design relative to 3-dimensional works.
2. Maintain a sketchbook/journal which documents the artistic process.
3. Demonstrate a mastery of basic ceramic construction: pinch, coil, slab, score /slip, carving, and combined techniques.
4. Become proficient on the potters wheel.
5. Create functional and sculptural ceramic artworks using hand building and wheel thrown techniques.
6. Use surface design, manipulation, and multimedia techniques to develop a personal voice and style.
7. Use the Elements of Art and Principles of Design to analyze and understand historical, cultural and personal artworks.
8. Draw inspiration from historical/cultural works to communicate personal ideas.
9. Develop and apply aesthetic theories to personal artworks and the work of others.
10. Use Elements of Art and Principles of Design to formulate written and verbal assessments/critiques of personal artworks.
