1st Grade Mathematics- What Your Child Will Learn

In **First Grade** your child will focus on working with whole numbers and place value including grouping tens and ones as they learn to add and subtract within 20. Instructional activities may include:

- Breaking up numbers less than or equal to 10 and then 20 in more than one way
- Quickly and accurately add numbers together that total up to 10 or less and subtract from numbers up through 10
- Solving word problems that involve adding and subtracting numbers to 20
- Understanding that the meaning of the equal sign (=) and determining if statements involving addition and subtraction are true or false
- Understanding place value of two-digit numbers by recognizing the value of each digit
- Comparing two-digit numbers using symbols > (greater than), < (less than), = (equal)
- Adding some two-digit numbers
- Measuring using a repeating unit (iterating) in order to compare the length of objects
- Telling time to nearest hour and half hour
- Using two- and three-dimensional shapes
