- For our current programming, we want to provide a place for those who consider themselves caregivers. We want them to be supported and learn more. We are working with caregivers to share experiences, offer suggestions for the community and guide the information and advice to go to the right organization. We are currently offering a parent/caregiver interest networking group and caregiver support group.
- In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, we have launched a series of informational and educational online “Town Hall” style events related to ASD and associated disorders.
