Dear Cabrillo Conq Families,

Now that we have received clearance from Santa Barbara County to return to in-person instruction, we are happy to announce the opening of our school on Monday, March 22, 2021 for Hybrid instruction. In December, every family responded to an LUSD survey indicating if they wanted their student to continue in Zoom instruction (Distance Learning or DL track) or return to in-person instruction (Hybrid or HY track) when schools reopened. Two master schedules were created and teacher staffing was assigned based on those choices. Because of class sizes and health and safety requirements, requests to change tracks may not be possible. Contact your son or daughter's counselor for more information.

Schedule Information

The daily schedule will look the same. Every student is assigned to Cohort A or Cohort B. Currently, classes are filled to capacity with the cohort designations as they are. The cohort assignment is visible in Q and dictates which day students will attend campus for in person learning. Click [here](#) for a short tutorial on how to see to which track and cohort your student is assigned.

Technology

All students will need to use a school-issued Chromebook while on campus as personal devices are restricted from accessing District WiFi. Additionally, only District computers will be able to be used for state testing. If your student has not yet received a school Chromebook, one will be issued the first day the student is on campus (Cohort A on Monday, 3/22; Cohort B on Thursday, 3/25). If your student is participating in Distance Learning, he/she may continue to use the personal device at home but a District Chromebook will be required for testing. Families may come to the school to check out a device Monday through Friday from 8:00–3:00.

Meals

All students are eligible to receive free breakfast and lunch daily and will not be required to enter their ID to get meals through the District. More information about meals will be available at our Reopening Meeting.
