Electives

FUHSD graduation requirements include taking 2 year-long courses (20 credits) in 2 of the 3 following selective elective areas: *Applied Academics, Fine Arts and World Language*. Students also need 70 elective credits which may include a combination of selective and general electives and academic courses taken beyond the minimum graduation requirements to meet *a-g* requirements for UC/CSU.
