Distance Learning

As stated in the Operating Procedures for 2020, if Albania determines that schools must close their campuses, TIS will provide educational services via online platforms and following the established distance learning plan. TIS needs to abide by the Albanian government's regulations and suggestions. If at any point it is mandated to close campus to students, we will need to follow these guidelines. In this case, we will be providing distance learning to any students that the closure applies to.

Distance Learning Platforms and Communication System at TIS

The following Online Platforms support both Distance Learning and faculty/student/family collaboration to ensure a quality student learning experience when planning and learning remotely:



Office 365 – All staff email accounts are through Office 365, along with a variety of tools to communicate and collaborate. Some tools, such as Teams will be used with students who are also issued school email accounts (11YO-SEC4). The Teams video conference platform may be used as the tool for video conferencing in those age groups.



<u>Seesaw</u> – is a platform for student engagement that provides creative tools to take pictures, draw, record videos, and more to capture learning in a portfolio. Teachers can find or create activities to share with students and parents (PreK-10YO).



Zoom – is a virtual classroom platform that may be used by lower preschool and lower elementary teachers. This is very easy for students and parents to access, as the classroom teacher simply sends a link via email for individuals to join the meeting/class (PreK-10YO).

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS for Distance Learning

Student Expectations:

- Be in class on time (Even better, go a little early and wait in the "waiting room" until class starts.) If you are too late, the session may be closed and you won't be able to attend.*
- · Join class from an appropriate location in your home
- Your screen name must be your name (first name only is fine)
- You should start class with Video ON during class, turn the video on or off according to teacher directions
- Your image when you turn the video off can be a picture of you or nothing no other pictures are allowed
- You should keep your microphone muted except to participate as the teacher directs
- Do not use any other meeting features unless your teacher directs you to

If a student needs additional guidance in order to abide by these expectations, the administration may need to get involved.

They will be available during each of those times (designated as Office Hours on the schedule) to work with students, either by invite or student drop-in. These Wednesday efforts are made to allow for more screen-time breaks.
