



Meal Service for School Reopening



Information for students and families

Elementary School In-Person Students:

- Students will be offered breakfast and lunch at dismissal to take home for the next day.
- To-go meals will be offered for virtual learning days.

Secondary School In-Person Students:

- Lompoc High School, Cabrillo High School, Lompoc Valley Middle School, and Vandenberg Middle School:
- Students will be offered lunch at school and breakfast to-go at dismissal.
- To-go meals will be offered for virtual learning days.

Maple High School

- Students will be offered breakfast at school and lunch to-go at dismissal.
- To-go meals will be offered for virtual learning days.

100% Distance Learners

- Distance learners can pick up meals from Maple High School or El Camino (West Chestnut and N. I St.) on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 11:00 AM - 12:00 PM.

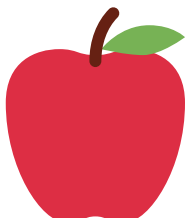
ASES

- Students who attend ASES will receive breakfast and lunch each day during ASES. They do not need to take home meals during class dismissal.

Food Safety for Grab & Go Meals

- Each meal package contains safe food handling and reheating instructions. Instructions can also be found on our website.
- Food should be eaten or refrigerated within two hours of receiving meal. Discard foods left out at room temperature for 2 hours or more.

Meals are free for all children 18 & under. One meal per child, please.
