GETTING STARTED

Your child was provided with a secure login and password that is unique to them.

Student logins are:

studentid#@student.tmisd.us

The password was created by your child, if they do not have or cannot remember their password please contact their teacher to get the password reset. This may take a while, but it will be done as soon as we can get to it.

You many also ask your teacher to add you as a parent via email!

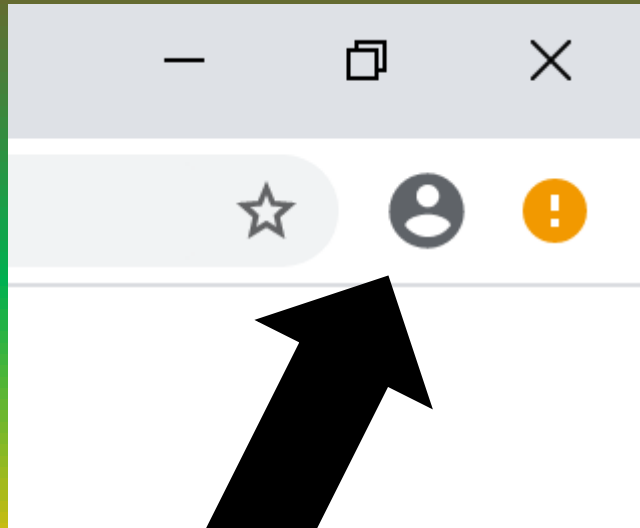

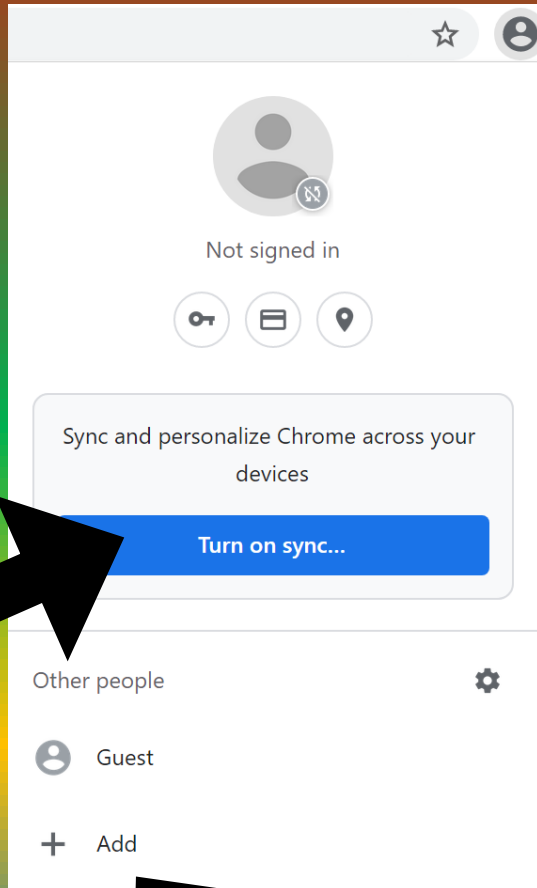

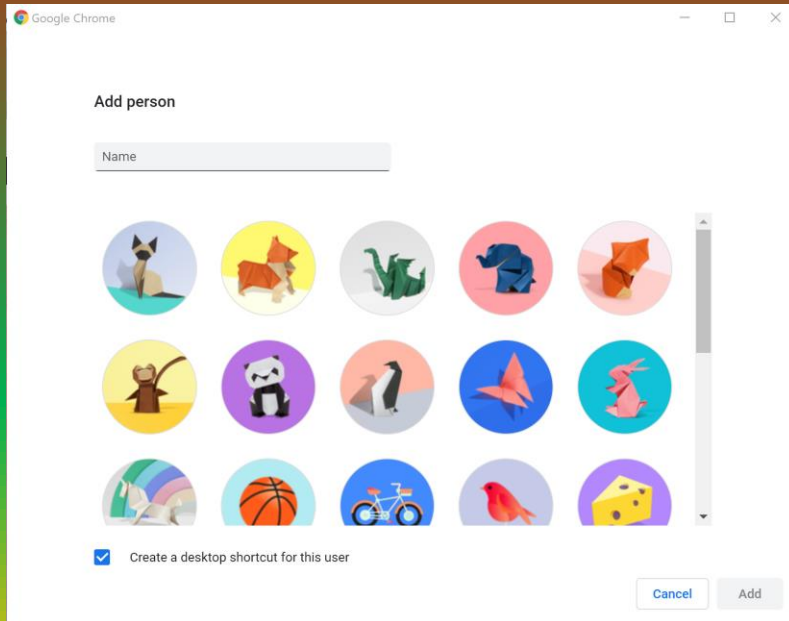

You will need to add a person to your account and then login into the account using their TMISD criteria (see slide 2). You can do so by Turn on sync... (blue button), this will appear if no one else is signed in, or hitting the + Add if someone is already logged in.



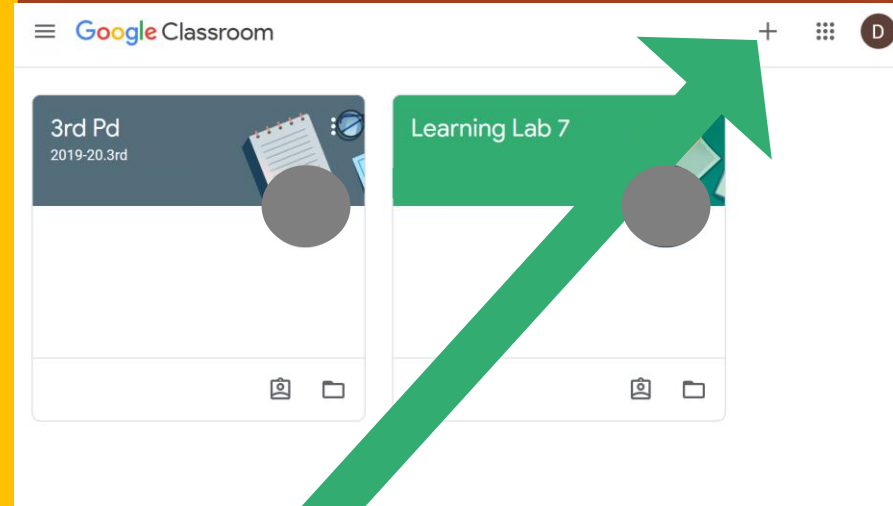

icon.



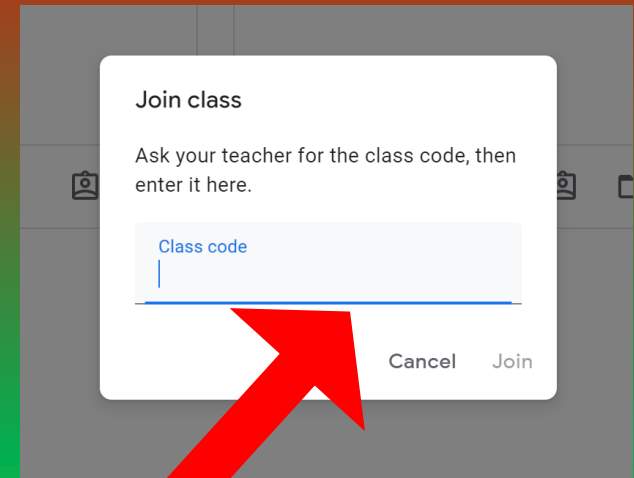
NAVIGATING CLASSROOM

NAVIGATING CLASSROOM

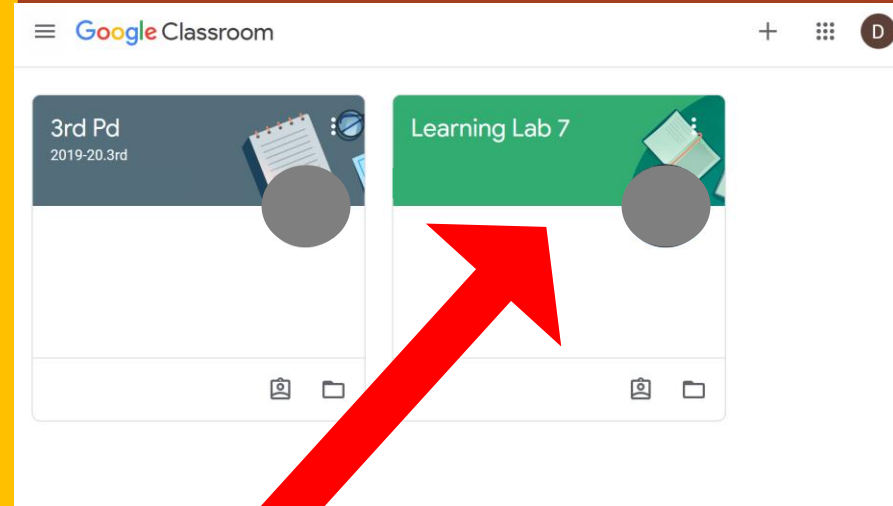

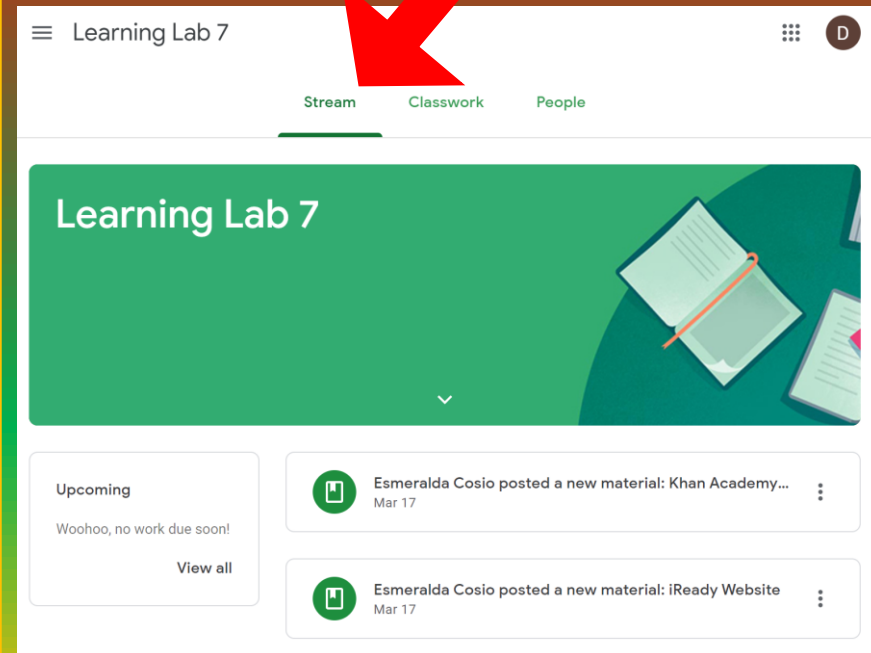

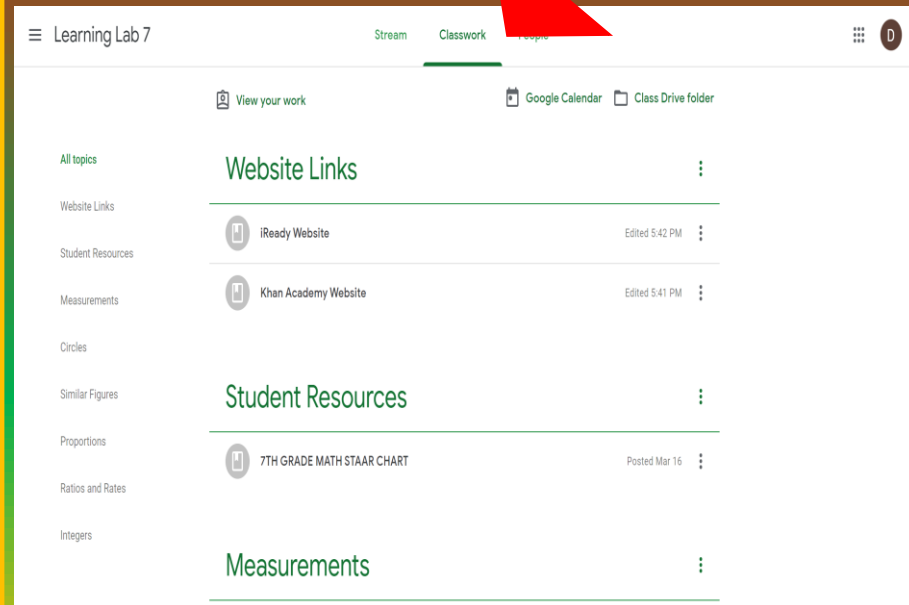
NAVIGATING CLASSROOM

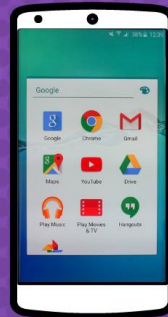
