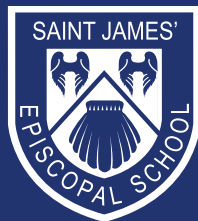
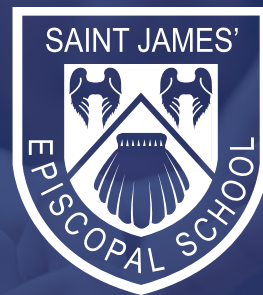

- 1. Tuition is listed as net; \$924,496 was distributed as Tuition Assistance.
- 2. Spring Event 2020 Netted \$148,339. Golf Tournament netted \$3,175.
- 3. Salaries and benefits includes teacher raises averaging 4%.
- 4. In 2018-19, the school completed the elementary campus “Believe Campaign” renovation. While the school paid for the construction as it occurred over the past few years, accounting rules require that this investment be allocated as an “expense” over the years the school expects to use the facility and new equipment (~\$300K Believe renovation-related depreciation expense).

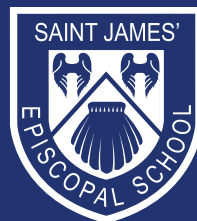
