Minutes

- Discussion about safety
 - David Hatch spoke with Josh Belnap at Kaysville City and Megan West spoke with a few City Council members
 - Opportunities include:
 - Speed limit signs
 - Cost is \$2,900/ea. and would need to be covered by resident or group of residents; City takes ownership and covers data connection and maintenance costs thereafter
 - Anticipate the need for 2 signs. School has access to separate funds that could potentially cover a portion of the costs
 - Similar signs were installed near Smith's on 200 N earlier this week; data being collected will determine impact of signs
 - Traffic study
 - City would cover cost, but study must be requested by resident living on impacted street and supported by at least 4 other residents
 - Body camera for crossing guard on 200 N
 - Cost TBD
 - Centerville City recently invested in body camera for crossing guard on high-traffic street
 - Stoplight to be installed at 200 N and Bonneville Lane
 - Timeline TBD
 - Cost covered by city
 - May impact existing traffic concerns
 - Decision
 - Community council will work with residents to request traffic study as a first step while Kaysville City measures impact of new signs on 200 N
 - Principal Andrews to confirm stoplight timeline with City and whether crosswalk will be moved from Wellington Drive to Bonneville Lane
 - Megan West to confirm costs of body camera and whether City will invest

- Total budget is \$81,134
- Council reviewed refinements to proposed goals and budgets in reading, math, technology, social and emotional learning, and sustainable development
- Council approved direction and initial budgets proposed
- KCE Administration and faculty will finalize budgets and goals for review and final approval by council in next meeting
