When can you apply? Now! We always accept new students during the school year (provided space is open).

2. ADMISSIONS APPOINTMENT: After completing the application, you will be contacted by the Admissions Office and asked to schedule an appointment for document drop-off and placement testing of your child(ren) (ages 6 and older take the test).

Prepare *copies* and bring these documents to your appointment:

- _____ Student passport (or Travel Permit)
- _ Student visa (or Travel Permit)
- _ First Parent/guardian passport *and* visa page (1 copy for each child)
- Second Parent/guardian passport *and* visa page (1 copy for each child)
- 1 passport-sized photograph of student
- _1 passport-sized photograph of both parents/guardians
- School records (grade reports / transcripts) from previous 2 years
- (with English translation if necessary)
- Student's immunization records

Prepare to pay the registration fee of **2,100 RMB (per child)** to the finance office during your appointment. This fee is non-refundable. **Please pay by bank transfer.**

ENTRANCE TESTING: Children ages 6 and up will take a placement test while the documents are collected:

- _ the test is on the computer, using a mouse
- the test is the NWEA MAP test for Reading, Language, and Math
- you can find a sample test here: https://studentresources.nwea.org/
- your child will also do a writing sample (handwritten)
- the test may take 30 minutes (younger children) to 2 hours (older children)
- there is no time limit for the test

3. INTERVIEW: Director of Instruction will review your child's file and test results and invite you for an interview. You will be informed by email of your acceptance, denial, or wait list offer.

4. DEPOSIT UPON ACCEPTANCE: If you are offered acceptance, please be prepared to pay a deposit of 15,600 RMB (per child) to save the space that has been offered. The deposit is **nonrefundable** and must be paid within 10 working days of the issue of the acceptance letter. The amount is applied to tuition; it is NOT an additional fee.
