Malcolm X was born on May 19, 1925, in Omaha Nebraska, and died on February 21, 1965, in New York, by an assassination

When Malcolm was little, he was moving to Michigan and his father Rev. Earl Little was Baptist minister and a former supporter of Marcus Garvey but died to a street car a possible victim of whites. The mother of Malcolm X, Louise Little was so poor when her husband died, she cooked dandelions and fed them to her kid and was committed by an insane asylum in 1939.

Malcolm now 6 is going to a foster or living with family and is excelling in school. One of the 8<sup>th</sup> grade teachers told him to be a carpenter than a lawyer. That's when he became street hustler, a drug dealer, and a gang leader.

Malcolm in jail from 1946 to 1952 for a robbery, and eventually talked to people and became apart of the Nation of Islam and changed his last name to X. The famous name Malcolm X because its tradition to change your last name, Malcolm Little.

Malcolm X after he came out of prison to become apart of the Nation of Islam, convinced by his brother Reginald. Malcolm X met many people and even gave speeches to the university of oxford and Harvard university. Malcolm challenged the mainstream of the civil rights movement Martin Luther King Jr because he didn't like how he did everything with nonviolence and told him that black people should defend themselves by everything means necessary. Malcolm Changed how black people are called, From "Negro" and "Colored" to "Black" and "Afro-American". Malcolm left the nation on Elijah Muhammad command and created and founded Muslim Mosque and changed his name to, el-Hajj Malik el-Shabazz
