

Before Jane got famous she went to smith college then she graduated and went to medical school.

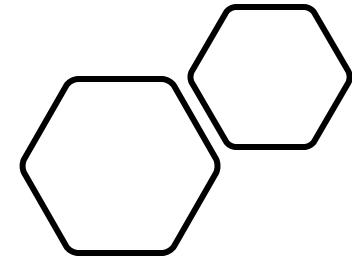




- She started by going to med school then she worked with her dad and she study cancer and treatments for cancer. She got started on her path because she wanted to solve cancer and find a treatment.


ACHIEVEMENT
