Physical Exam/Immunization Requirements

St. David's School requires a completed physical examination form for **all new students** (including pre-K and kindergarten) as well as all students wishing to participate in athletics. It is important for your physician to be specific with information regarding your child's health and immunization dates (month, day and year required). The student's health forms must be completed and signed by the physician and submitted **before August 1** to Magnus Health SMR, St. David's School's online medical record database.

North Carolina immunization law states that each student enrolled in kindergarten through twelfth grades (both public and non-public) must be immunized. All pre-K students must submit proof of immunizations that are age appropriate. The following are the required immunizations:

- **DPT** (Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus) – 5 doses
- **Hepatitis B** – 3 doses
- **Hib** (Haemophilus influenza type B) – 4 doses – for children under age 5
- **Measles** – 2 doses (MMR covers Measles, Mumps and Rubella)
- **Meningococcal** – 2 doses. One dose is required for individuals entering 7th grade or by age 12, whichever comes first. A booster dose is required for individuals entering 12th grade or by age 17, whichever comes first. Individuals who entered 7th grade before July 1, 2015 are not required to receive the first dose. If the first dose is administered on or after age 16, a booster dose is not required. The vaccine is not required if born before Jan. 1, 2003.
- **Mumps** – 2 doses
- **Pneumococcal Conjugate**- 4 doses (not required if born before July 1, 2015)
- **Polio** – 4 doses
- **Rubella** – 1 dose
- **Tdap** (Tetanus, Diphtheria/Pertussis booster)-1 dose before 7th grade or age 12, whichever comes first.
- **Varicella** – 2 doses (2nd dose not required if started Kindergarten before 2015 and there is an exception for history of varicella documented by a health care provider)
