<p><b><u>SUMMARY OF AWARDS &amp; SCHOLARSHIPS</u></b></p> <p><b>Instrumental Award 3:</b> is intended for girls who have already made considerable progress towards higher levels of achievement.</p> <p><b>Choral Award:</b> to encourage high standards of singing in both solo and choir work.</p> <p><b>Organ Award:</b> to encourage girls to learn the organ. Candidates should already be competent pianists.</p> <p><b>Instrumental Award 1:</b> to encourage girls to take up less familiar instruments, e.g. Viola, Double Bass, Bassoon, French Horn, Lower Brass &amp; Oboe. <i>Please check availability before applying</i></p> <p><b>Sixth Form Music Scholarship:</b> is awarded to a girl of proven high musical ability (approaching Grade 8 in her first instrument/voice would be expected as a minimum). Ability in a second instrument/voice would be a distinct advantage. The holder would be expected to take a full and active part in the School’s music, and it is expected that she will study A Level music.</p> <p><b>Jennifer Bate Memorial Organ Scholarship with Guildford Cathedral:</b> is offered to girls who are already advanced organists and who are intending to apply for organ scholarships, or further their organ studies, at university, conservatoire, or cathedrals post-18.</p>
