OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY CLASS D AND MOTORCYCLE EXAMS AT MNTC

EXAM INFORMATION

- 1. ONLY the Class D and Motorcycle written exams can be taken at MNTC.
- 2. Appointments are required. NO walk ins.
- 3. A valid, current photo ID, school ID or Birth Certificate is required to test.
- 4. Tester must be at least 14 to test for motorcycle driving exam and 15 ½ to test for Class D.
- 5. MNTC does NOT administer the eye exam or the driving exam. They must be completed at a DPS testing location.
- 6. All exams will be proctored by assessment staff and recorded via video.
- 7. The exam is 20 questions and will be administered on a computer.
- 8. There is no time limit on the exam.
- 9. A 75% or higher is a passing score.
- 10. The exam can be taken only 1 time per day. Appointments will be required for retake exams and must be scheduled at least 48 hours in advance. Retake exams will still cost \$28.50 (including convenience fee).
- 11. A signed and stamped score sheet will be given to all examinees. Examinees that pass the exam will take the signed and stamped copy of the score sheet to a DPS testing location. SCEDULING INFORMATION FOR MNTC

- 1. Exams must be scheduled and paid for through RegisterBlast. Links to schedule are below:
 - a. Franklin Road Campus (Norman) www.registerblast.com/mntc
 - b. South Penn (south OKC) www.registerblast.com/mntc-penn
- 2. Exams must be scheduled at least 48 hours in advance.
- 3. Exam cost is \$25 plus a \$3.50 convenience fee for a total of \$28.50.
- 4. Exam seats are limited.
- 5. Bring a valid, current photo identification issued by government entity within the U.S. (e.g., passport, driver's license, school-issued ID) or birth certificate. ID will be verified by DPS.
- 6. Please do not arrive more than 15 minutes before your appointment time.
- 7. The state testing system requires the last 5 numbers of your SSN to schedule an exam. If you do not have a SSN, enter the last 5 numbers of your ID Card or Birth Certificate.

- 3. Present your signed/stamped score sheet along with all other required documentation.
- 4. You will need a primary and secondary form of ID, see list at this link: <u>https://oklahoma.gov/content/dam/ok/en/dps/docs/us-citizen-primary-proof-of-identification.pdf</u>
- 5. Test scores are valid for one year.
- 6. The Class D Driving Exam is the test used for a driving permit. The driving exam will be taken at the end of the 6 month waiting period. The waiting period does not start until after you have completed the full application process with DPS.
