2012-2013 School Year

What is SES?

SES stands for Supplemental Education Services. SES are after school tutoring services available for low income students at Title I schools who are at AYP Level 2 School Improvement or higher. For the 2012-2013 school year we have five schools that are eligible for SES:

- George Morgan Sr. School in Kalskag, Level 5
- Zackar Levi Elementary School in Lower Kalskag, Level 4
- Joseph & Olinga Gregory Elementary School in Upper Kalskag, Level 4
- Crow Village Sam School in Chuathbaluk, Level 3
- Aniak Jr. Sr. High School in Aniak, Level 2

Following is a chart that shows the number of students who have participated in SES after school tutoring the past five years.
