<p>Create a character profile of a Stone Age child. What is his/her character like? What does he/she look like? What do they like doing? Remember to include adjectives!</p>	<p>Investigate! Research about different types of rock. Can you find examples? Where in the world do you find these rocks?</p>	<p>Create a fact file about the different types of food which Stone Age people might have eaten. What animals were available, and what else might they have eaten? Can you create a menu?</p>
<p>Create a piece of music using instruments from natural and man-made objects e.g. stick, stones, pipes. You could film yourself performing and email it to the office!</p>	<p>Research about fossils. How are they created? Can you create or draw one?</p>	<p>Design and make a Stone Age tool which will fit into your book bag. What could its use be? Building? Cooking? Cleaning?</p>
<p>Write a diary entry in the role of a Stone Age child. Remember to use the features of a diary (Dear Diary, first person, past tense).</p>	<p>Money challenge! Using a shopping receipt (maybe the weekly shop) can you find a combination of items that add up to £10? How close can you get? Try lots of different ways!</p>	<p>Learn a poem or a Fairytale by heart which you can perform to your peers.</p>
<p>Make a cave painting using natural products e.g. mud, berries, vegetable juice etc. Take a photo of it to show the class.</p>	<p>Write an Adventure Story or a Quest Story about Stone Age characters. (Think about your characters, opening, build up, problem, resolution and ending).</p>	<p>Research: Can you find evidence of Stone Age settlements in Britain?</p>
