York Drama's 2021 Winter Production Film: "The Laramie Project" - Tickets On Sale Now

York Community High School Drama Department presents the "The Laramie Project," a reaction to the story of Matthew Shepard, a gay University of Wyoming student, who

was killed in 1998 in Laramie, Wyoming. His murder was denounced as a hate crime and brought attention to the lack of hate crime laws in various states, including Wyoming.

Since live theatre is on pause, York decided to create something special and produce The Laramie Project as a film. Student Directors Olivia Rosenberg, Charlie Kungl, Jillian Caforio and Owen Espinosa, and Stage Managers Henry Wegener and Kayla Willey are heading the team, along with York alumni Matt Bourke and film director Michael Berry.

The Laramie Project runs from March 26, 27, 28 and April 4 and 5th. Tickets are on sale now at www.ticketpeak.co/yorkdrama and are \$5 per viewing link plus a \$1.50 service charge. Donations are welcome and much appreciated, as York Drama continues to create art during this unprecedented year. This is presented as an on-demand streaming with viewing links active between 5:00pm CST – Midnight CST each day of the show. Each day will require a new code, if you want to watch multiple days.

D205 schools also is handing out an optional (students are not required to take a meal bag) shelf stable, one-day meal bag each day at dismissal time for students in grades K-12. Breakfast for the following morning is included in the bag as well. Families with allergy concerns or other dietary restrictions should contact your school nurse's office to discuss your child's specific situation before allowing your child to bring home a meal kit. If you do not want your child to take a meal kit home, please tell your child and let the school nurse know. The food items offered in the lunch bag each day will vary. If your child is taking a meal kit home, please remind them that food is not to be eaten on the bus, and the food should not be shared with anyone due to concerns with food allergies and other dietary restrictions.
