Principal Report:

- Digital Citizenship Survey Discussion:
 - a. Netsmart assembly happened.
 - b. 8 questions in survey to parents. Added 1 more – Do parents know kids have access on devices to the whole district using teams?
- Budget Report:

Will have carry over for next year. To reach the 10% or less carryover \$5,700 used for teacher training this year with LETRS.

 - a. Motion to amend budget: Motioned by April Pohlman/Seconded by Jen Matthews. Motion passes. Hilaree Lowry will approve motion with school board.
 - b. Aides using less hours than anticipated.
 - c. Update teacher devices, replace desktops, projectors, apple tv's – no carry over with TSSA funds.
- Review Goals for 2021-2022:
 - 1. English/Language Arts, Science, & Math:
 - a. Keep reading goals same as last year. \$40,000 – towards aides. 75% of 3-6 students will show proficiency on RISE Writing Benchmark. 77% of K-3 students will show typical/higher progress, 87% of 4-6 students will have composite score at/above benchmark. 68% of 3-6 students will have average proficiency on ELA RISE.
 - b. GoMath may no longer be available/possible name change? Still have one more year paid for. Math committee will look at alternatives. \$30,000/TSSA – towards aides. Common math vocabulary, increase proficiency by 2% based on summative CRT and Rise Assessment.
 - 2. Science/Stem:
 - a. \$4000/Trust Lands, \$9000/TSSA – Continue with InfiniD K-6/each class once/term

- b. \$3300 Robotics program
- 3. Social & Emotional Learning:
 - a. \$11,500/Trust Lands (\$10,000/Aide-\$1500/incentives) ELA and Math will increase through Positive Behavior Intervention Supports System.
- 4. Digital Citizenship:

- Discussed summer school at Burton. Possible M-TH 8:30-11am time frame for 7 weeks. Need funding for busses. Possible before and after school tutoring come fall.
- Motion: Proposed Budget for 2021-2022, motioned by April Pohlman/Seconded by Jen Matthews. Motion passes.
- Need to meet in April and May (elections for next years council)
