This plan has been developed in accordance with Commissioner's Regulations 90.18 Plan of Service (ix) the plan for cooperative collection development implementation.

**Goal**

To improve the quality of education for students in the Wayne-Finger Lakes BOCES region by providing increased access to a greater diversity of digital content (e-books and audio books) through a coordinated cooperative collection development program.

**Objectives**

1. Contribute to digital member libraries collections in the W-FL region
2. Develop digital library collections that support special clients or curriculum, AASL Standards for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learner, and the New York State Learning Standards
3. Increase student and staff access to diverse and inclusive digital content

**Governance**

The School Library System Council and the Director will oversee the selection of CCD funded digital content. The SLS Council will:

1. Make suggestions for themes or genres to focus on each year
2. Review the title selections before purchase
3. Work with the Communications Coordinators and other school librarians to promote CCD funded digital content

**Member Responsibilities**

Members of the Wayne-Finger Lakes BOCES School Library System are expected to participate in the Cooperative Collection Development Program. Members will:

1. Agree to implement and/or utilize the Sora digital platform
2. Promote and encourage students and staff to use CCD funded digital content
3. Provide feedback about the CCD program on the End of Year evaluation

**Evaluation**

This plan will be reviewed and evaluated by the SLS Council on an annual basis. Criteria used to determine effectiveness of the program includes:

1. Usage statistics
2. Input from SLS Council
3. Information received from responses on SLS annual evaluation
