

Student Schedule

Middle and High School students will be available on the first day of school. Elementary and Preschool homeroom teachers will share their weekly schedule with parents.

Parent Teacher Organization (PTO)

Our PTO organizes a number of events throughout the year for the school and community. This is a group of elected parents who volunteer their time, effort, and energy to make our school a better place and build community.

Busing

MIDDLE SCHOOL



Dear Kyiv International School Parents and Students,

I hope you are as excited as I am to kickstart a brand new school year! Luckily, the Middle School will see far fewer changes compared to last year, so our returning students will not have as much to get used to! Here are some things for students to keep in mind:

- 1) We will continue with a Block schedule this year, meaning students will have four classes per day for 90 minutes, rather than eight classes per day. This will minimize the amount of interruptions to the day for teachers and students, and will open up more opportunities for individualized instruction, cooperative learning, and varying of activities.
- 2) We will continue "Kozak 30" this year, similar to last year. This will be a time in the middle of the day (before lunch) in which students can get extra help from teachers, relax, take part in a variety of activities, and even guide and create programs based on their interests.
- 3) We are excited to add two new teachers to the already strong Middle School team; Shannon Butler, who will teach 11 yo Reading and Writing as well as 12 and 13 yo Drama, and Helen Kasian will join us as the Art teacher. We also have a new Middle School Counselor, Chelsey Zoromski. All three are excited to be working with our Middle School students this year and we are happy to have them!
- 4) One big change is how we will schedule Week Without Walls this year. In the past, all MS students attended a Week Without Walls trip in June, near the end of the school year. This year, we have decided to spread the trips out a bit, causing less disruption to the already stressful end of the school year. 11 year old parents and students should be aware that all 11 year old students will have the opportunity to go on a Week Without Walls trip during the last full week in September. Other trips will be decided by committee for later in the school year. (More detailed information will be sent out soon!)

The first day of school is right around the corner, and I am looking forward to greeting our KIS Middle School Community (students and parents if they wish) in the New Gym on August 22nd at 8:10. I also plan to meet with all parents in attendance once we get the students off to their rotations for the day. There will be a brief time for teachers to meet and greet parents while students receive their schedules and interact with each other. This is a half-day, so dismissal will be at 11:30.

I am greatly looking forward to a new school year and all of the new opportunities and experiences it will bring! See you all on August 22nd!

SECONDARY SCHOOL



Dear Secondary Parents and Students,

I am excited to welcome you to the 2019-20 year at Kyiv International School! The faculty and staff are busy, preparing the school for an exciting year of learning and growth. I look forward to hearing about your summer adventures, getting caught up with returning families, and meeting our newest Kozaks.

This school year there are many exciting changes on campus, and the ones that affect secondary students the most are:

- Renovated and updated library space -- an entirely redesigned library with dedicated space for secondary students to study in a quiet environment.
- Added cafeteria space -- essentially doubling the cafeteria seating capacity and opening an additional food line for faster service.
- Migration to Office 365 learning platform -- every student will have a school email account through Microsoft, including up to 5 downloads of the Microsoft Office Suite on any device with any operating system.

Here is some important KIS back-to-school information:

Thursday, August 22

- Half day Orientation and team building
- Students arrive by 8:10 and are dismissed at 11:30.
- Students will receive schedules, textbooks, and lockers; be reminded of school procedures and expectations; and participate in team-building activities.
- There is no lunch service Thursday.
- The KFN snack bar will be open.

Friday, August 23

- Full day first day of regular classes
- Students arrive between 8:00 8:10.
- School begins at 8:10 with dismissal at 15:35.
- Lunch service is provided Friday.
- Students should bring a snack. The KFN snack bar will be open.
- Friday is a **Black** day, meaning that students will meet with their courses listed as **Black**, according to their schedules.

Student success is the goal of every staff member at KIS, and we believe that, with our mastery-learning structure and dedication to high-quality, research-based learning activities, every student will reach their potential.

SECONDARY SCHOOL

To ensure that we have a successful year, I ask just one thing from each of you. Students, I ask that you come to school ready to learn every day, and, parents, I ask that you encourage your child to attend school regularly, which includes planning your holidays around school holidays. We are prepared to offer time and support as needed, and when students attend at least 90% of scheduled classes, we are able to provide that support. Students who miss more than 10% of their classes run the risk of falling seriously behind.

Teachers will provide students with a list of supplies required for each subject. Because we focus on 21st century skills, it is expected that every student will have her or his own laptop to be used at school as well as adequate internet access at home.

I know that there can be many questions and anxieties at the start of anything new, especially a new school year. Rest assured that I am here to assist you, as are all members of the secondary admin team--Ms. Marianna Kotelnykova (Administrative Assistant), Ms. Shanna Tempel (Secondary Counselor and AP Coordinator), and Ms. Randi Assenova (IB Coordinator).

Campus Security

Kyiv International School strives to provide your children with a safe and positive educational environment at all times. Our facilities are meant to be for students, staff, and parents to build school community and promote student and community activities. In alignment with the school's Child Protection Policies and Procedures, CEESA guidelines, and updated Middle States Accreditation requirements, KIS would like to inform everyone of the following campus safety and security regulations:

Car Access Stickers

For cars to access the territory, you must have a new parking sticker for the 2019 - 2020 school year. These stickers are available at reception.



Adult ID's

All adults planning to be on campus must have an ID. If you do not have one already, please arrange to register for one from reception, and wear it at all times while at the school. The school must know who is on our campus and why at all times.

Nannies, Family Caregivers, and Bodyguards

KIS has qualified and trained teachers and teaching assistants who care for your children, as they learn to be personally **independent** and **responsible**. To encourage independence in our students, nannies, family caregivers, drivers and bodyguards are requested not to wait on the school premises during school hours.

Drop off – we ask that nannies, caregivers, drivers, and bodyguards, who are dropping off students in the morning, please **depart from the school campus by 8:35 AM.**

Pick up – we ask that nannies, caregivers, drivers, and bodyguards, who are picking up students in the afternoon, to only come on campus **after 3:00 PM and wait in the pick up zones, which include the main lobby and back courtyard.** Students will not be dismissed until 3:35. We ask parents, drivers, and caregivers to wait for students in these zones and not go directly to the classroom.

Special Activities and Events - if there is a special activity, event, or performance that is open to parents, caregivers will also be permitted on campus to take pictures and videos for parents who cannot attend.

Closed Campus

Kyiv International School is a closed campus. Once on campus, students are not permitted to leave the campus without parental permission and office approval before 3:35pm. Parents are asked to contact the divisional office managers if their child plans to leave school early. If a student feels unwell at school, the office staff will notify their parents and arrangements will be made to leave school. Students are not permitted to leave campus without prior parent written notification. Any students who leave campus will not be permitted to return on the same day without specific approval and permission.

Picking Up Students in the Middle of the Day

Parents and caregivers should go to reception to notify the school that they are picking up any student(s) and wait in the lobby while reception calls the teacher or department. School staff will escort the student to the lobby for pick up, if needed. An exit slip will be issued to show security when leaving early. In an effort of accountability, this helps the school to better know who is on and off campus at all times, each day. If you have any questions or concerns about these policies, please don't hesitate to set up a meeting with security and administration.

KIS Parking and Traffic Guidelines

Kyiv International School, as always, remains open to all parents and visitors. We want you to feel welcome and be a part of the school community. Our doors are always open!

The school also recognizes the importance of student safety and security. For this reason, we want to communicate the parking and traffic guidelines at the school.

- All parent parking will be off campus in the school parking lot.
- There will be two exceptions to this for the drop off and pick up time.
- During this time, we ask parents to "drop and go" in the morning and "park and pick up" in the afternoon.
- Anyone intending to spend more time than this should park off campus.

We appreciate your cooperation and support in this, as we make efforts to keep all childrent safe at school. Please look closely at the map and description of the different zones at the school. Please be patient with the school guards and staff and we try to manage traffic and make this as efficient and safe as possible.

Green Zone

Parent and visitor parking only - open at all times for those wishing to enter the school and stay for longer times.

Yellow Zone - Short time (Stop & Go)

Morning Drop Off - (7:30 - 8:30)

Please drop off students with the help of school volunteers to make sure students safely exit and enter the school grounds. Please do not park. Afternoon Pick Up - (3:00 - 4:00)

Those hoping to quickly pick up students and depart the school between the 3:45-4:00 time.

* Important note:

The road will be blocked from entering the red zone until the buses have departed from the school at 3:45. Following the departure of buses, the red zone will open for through traffic. If you are in a hurry to depart the school, please consider parking in the green zone.


