#### **ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

KIS's writing curriculum allows for a multitude of writer's workshops throughout the year slowly releasing the independence of correcting ones' mistakes.

For each published piece of writing I meet with the student one on one, three times. The first meeting we go over ideas and organization to create a rough draft. Once the rough draft is finished, they meet with me again to go over sentence fluency, voice and word choice. My final meeting with them is to discuss conventions, and they publish their writing. Through the year I create writing partners and the meetings with me slowly decrease to one time in which we only discuss ideas and organization. Students will confidently use the knowledge of a writer's workshop throughout their academic career.

AP Chemistry students are testing the effects of pressure, temperature and volume on various gases. What? Did I hear you ask why study such a boring topic? No the answer is not "so students can pass the AP test and get into a good university." Zorka, a Secondary IV student has this to say about purpose of studying gas laws: "The gas laws pretty much govern our entire lives.
