# KIS Parking, Traffic, Drop Off, and Pick Up Guidelines

Unfortunately, this year Kyiv International School campus will be generally closed to all parents and visitors. We will be accommodating parents and visitors who have appointments for any school business.

Green Zone - Parent and visitor parking only - open at all times. Morning Drop Off — (7:50 - 8:30)

- Students will not be able to be dropped off before 7:50
- 5yo- S4 Students will need to be dropped off outside the guard check.
- Cars will be permitted to drive through the campus for traffic flow purposes.
- Parents wishing to drop off high school students in the back may drive through campus, but must drop off students outside the back gate. Students should go straight to their classroom.

Yellow Zone – Inside Parking Lot Afternoon Pick Up — (3:00-4:00)

- Parents and caregivers will be able to park in the yellow zone to pick up students, but are not permitted to enter the campus.
- Please, wait outside or in your car until your child finds you.
- KIS staff will be outside to help locate parents/caregivers.
- Once you have picked up your child, you must leave the campus.



Wear a mask at all times while on campus for pick up.




Spread out and keep socially distant from other parents and caregivers.

Red Zone - Staff and school bus parking only




# Campus Security & ID's

# **Car Access Stickers**

For cars to access the territory, you must have a new parking sticker (yellow) for the 2020-2021 school year. These stickers are available at reception. You will notice there is a special car sticker for preschool parents who will need to park on campus to drop their children off at a side door for a temperature check and entry.







# Adult ID's


All adults planning to be on campus must have an ID. If you do not have one already, please arrange to register for one from reception, and wear it at all times while at the school.

# **Closed Campus**

Kyiv International School is a closed campus. Once on campus, students are not permitted to leave the campus without parental permission and office approval before 3:35pm. Parents are asked to contact the divisional office managers if their child plans to leave school early.

# Picking Up Students in the Middle of the Day

Parents and caregivers should go to the front or back gate to notify the school that they are picking up any student(s) and wait off campus.



# How to use a mask?

## **Before Putting on a Mask:**

Clean hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.

# While Wearing a Mask:

- 1. **Cover your mouth and nose.** Make sure there are no gaps between your face and the mask.
- 2. **Avoid touching the mask**. If you do, clean your hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.
- 3. Replace the mask with a new one as soon as it is damp. **Do not re-use single-use masks.**





# To dispose of the mask:

- 1. Remove the mask from behind using the strings. **Do not touch the front of mask.** 
  - 2. Discard the mask **immediately** in a closed bin.
  - 3. Clean hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.



# Bring Your Own Device Upper Elementary (8yo+), Middle School & Secondary Students

More and more students are bringing their computers, tablets, and other devices to school to use as a learning resource to complete school assignments, research topics, and keep track of homework and school events. All KIS Upper Elementary (8yo +) Middle School and Secondary students will need to have their own personal device to use as a resource at school. It is also possible that KIS may need to temporarily move to online learning. In such circumstances, it is important that students are equip to transition quickly to continue with the school's Virtual Learning Environment.

#### **BYOD Resources:**

Microsoft 365 – School Email Account, Teams, Microsoft Office, etc.

Student will have a school email account and cloud storage via Microsoft 365, which will allow teachers and students to share and edit documents. There are also a number of apps and programs related to the Microsoft 365 platform.

Digital Version of Textbooks

Online textbooks and resources will be available for students to use. Paper textbooks will still be used and available, but not mandatory.

Online Programs and Resources

There are a number of online resources and programs that a teacher may use

#### Possible Devices:

- Laptops Macbooks, Chromebooks, or any other type of laptop.
- 2 in 1's Can double as a tablet and computer (Microsoft Surface)
- Must be able to print from device.
- Must have a keyboard in order to do word processing.
- Minimum of one USB port.



# **Device specifications**

- 1) Wireless connectivity Devices must support 2.4GHz and 5GHz dual band, 802.11 a, b, g and n wireless so that they can connect to the school WiFi.
- **2) Battery life** Devices must last at least 3-5 hours without charge so that it can last through multiple classes throughout the school day.
- **3) Memory and RAM** Devices must have a minimum 16 GB of free (available) storage and 8 GB RAM so that students have enough space to save their work and have a device that is fast to work with.
- **4) Operating system** Devices should have the current version of any operating system (Eg. MacOS13 iOS13, Windows 10) so the device can access the latest software/apps and updates. If this is not possible, a previous version of any operating system should be installed on devices (Eg. iOS11, Windows 8) but proper use of all applications is not guaranteed.
- 5) Hardware features Devices must have a camera and microphone to allow students to participate in 21st century learning. Students may also find a mouse and stylus helpful.

# **KFN COVID-19 RULES**


The following simple precautions may prevent infection:

- 1) Before entering the Cafeteria, please wash and disinfect your hands well.
- 2) Please, keep distance 1.5m according to the floor marking.
- 3) No more than 4 people can sit at one table.
- 4) You can remove the mask and open the lunch box after taking your place at the table.
- 5) It is forbidden to share your food with friends.
- 6) No cash payment allowed in Cafeteria! Please, don't forget always have your debit card with you.
- 7) When you finish your lunch it is mandatory to put a clean mask on. The used one, please, dispose in a special container.
- 8) Please return used disposable lunch boxes, cups and cutlery for recycling.

KFN will continue to work closely with KIS regarding protocols used for masks, students seating, and other lunch service arrangements. We will have many signs up reminding students and school staff of safe lunchroom procedures.
