Council members discussed the **draft** of the proposed Board Report, Teacher Success Plan, TSSA, and Land Trust.

The following is a summary of the proposed **draft** report for the 2022 school year.

Goal 1: Reading At-Risk Students

We will progress monitor identified students between benchmark testing to determine adequate progress towards the BOY thru EOY benchmark goals.

Students: build student ownership of learning through choice of texts, books, and learning activities. They will also track their progress using digital or data folders.

Teachers: Targeted professional learning in Heggerty, LETRS, and continued PLC work including PD/workdays throughout the summer.

Parents: Will have their student read 20 minutes every day outside of school.

Goal TSSA Expense total - \$105,000.00
(five extra teacher days \$75,000.00 - Stipends for LETRS trainings \$30,000.00)

Goal 2: Math All students will show a 15% increase in Numbers and Operations grades 1-6.

All students will take either RISE or CRT benchmark tests, BOY, MOY, and EOY to track progress throughout the year.

Students: Build student ownership of learning through use of online math subscriptions to track progress and learning activities.

Teachers: Will use digital tools to track, assign, and group students for additional help and to target instruction.

Parents: Will support their student with additional math practice daily.

Goal TSSA Expense total: \$37,000
(Software/Technology Hardware \$25,000.00 - Online curriculum or subscriptions \$12,000.00)
