OSSD MOVES TO AT-HOME LEARNING ON THURSDAY DUE TO HURRICANE ZETA

OCEAN SPRINGS, MS (OSSD) -- Due to Hurricane Zeta's increase in intensity during the overnight hours, Ocean Springs School District has adjusted its plans for Thursday and will operate an "at-home learning" schedule Thursday (10/29) as Zeta impacts coastal Mississippi. The district is scheduled to resume normal in-person operations on Friday, October 30th.

What does "at-home learning" mean for your student?

Our teachers are prepared to teach virtually tomorrow and information will be provided to your student prior to dismissal on Wednesday. ***Students continuing their studies at home on Thursday means the day will count as a school day and will not have to be made up this school year.***
