If the numbers support that, we were still fine, because we still had a choice. BUT NOW At last week's board meeting, Leslie Weber and soon to leave Supt Moyer said this new REACH proposal was 2 years in the making. So it seems to many of us that a plan was made by Dr. Moyer and admin without Conrad Fischer families (and possibly the board) aware of such a change. We are extremely upset. Our kids children have the right to stay in their community whether they want dual language or mono. Forcing families to choose to be bused to another school or go dual language is not fair to the families in our neighborhood.</p>
