


#### Q1 Please indicate your child's division.





## Q3 How would you rate FIS' efforts to create and maintain a safe and healthy school environment?





## Q4 How would you describe your own personal outlook in relation to the ongoing COVID-19 crisis here in the Frankfurt-Wiesbaden area?





## Q5 How would you describe your child's outlook in relation to the ongoing COVID-19 crisis here in the Frankfurt-Wiesbaden area?





## Q6 What is your reaction to the German government's decision to continue with home learning for Grades 7-10 at least until after the upcoming spring break?




