Initial ARD: The start disability start date must match the date of the ARD start date. A student cannot have an instructional setting vector (tracked in placement record) without a disability and a student cannot have a disability record without an instructional setting vector.

Annual / Reevaluation ARD- change of Primary Disability: When a disability changes as in the example below, you must end the current disability the day before the new disability begins. The new disabilities must have a start date that matches the ARD start date.

Based on the evaluation data reviewed, the ARD committee has determined that the student:

does NOT meet eligibility criteria to receive special education services.

Multiple Disabilities (screen shot from student summary screen): The code for Multiple Disabilities must have a priority of 9 to report to PEIMS. Disability information with priority numbers 1-3 and 9 report to PEIMS.
