At Cabrillo, students are nurtured to become compassionate, reflective, and inclusive individuals, while also being challenged to become resilient and inquisitive life-long learners.



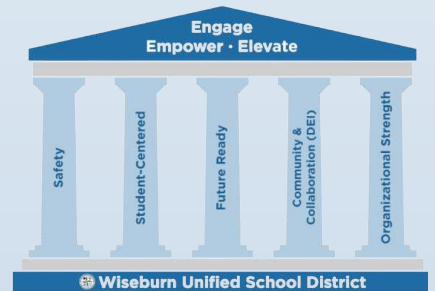

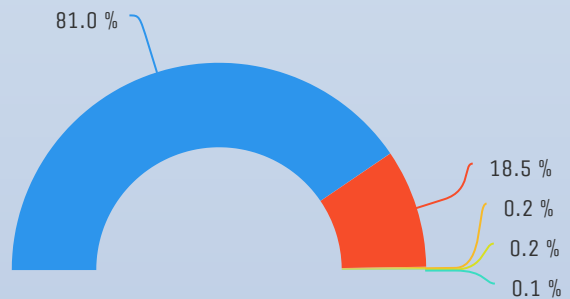

Goals and Key Actions

GOAL 1 Safety



Cabrillo school will ensure equitable conditions of learning to all students through safe and secure campuses, access to highly qualified teachers and required materials, as well as programs and resources to ensure their social-emotional wellbeing.

- Custodians and grounds crew will continue to complete their daily and weekly cleaning schedules, which have been adjusted to reflect increased cleaning and sanitation needs in the wake of COVID-19. In addition, custodial team will continue to complete deep cleaning of our facilities during all breaks and summer vacation.
- 100% of our teachers are fully credentialed and are appropriately assigned as measured by human resources assignment monitoring reports.
- Assistant principal will also support the IEP process as an administrative designee, facilitate Student Study Teams, and guide the Positive Behavior Supports and Intervention team.
- Purchases of individual school supplies for each student, to support safety and reduce contact in light of COVID-19.
- Implementation of elevated cleaning, campus visitation, and safety protocols to maintain the health and safety of all students.

GOAL 2 Student-Centered



Cabrillo School will ensure an instructional program that is focused on supporting individual student growth and achievement, as well as social-emotional development, by creating systems that meet the needs of all students.

- Support positive student behavior and social-emotional well-being with age-appropriate resources and qualified staff.
- Cabrillo's Guided Coalition (GC) of teachers represent each grade level to help guide grade level teams through work focused on analysis of standards, creation of common assessments, analysis of student data, and reflection on instructional practices.
- Cabrillo will supply students and teachers with the instructional supplies needed to support student learning and growth.
- Cabrillo will support its English Language Learners through both integrated and designated instruction.
- Cabrillo will run an ongoing intervention program to provide academic support for identified students.
- The CARE team of counselors will provide all teachers with lesson materials and resources through a CARE website and visits to staff meetings.

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Future-Ready

Cabrillo school will ensure that students are equipped for future success by focusing on collaboration, critical thinking, problem solving, and creativity across all curricular areas, while also nurturing student growth as confident, resilient learners, and responsible citizens.

- Continue to provide access to instructional materials in print or electronic forms to 100% of students, including by continuing our one-to-one technology for all students in grades K-2.
- Cabrillo will replace and repair classroom technology, as needed, to provide equitable conditions for learning for all students and ensure the use of future ready strategies in all classes.
- Teachers were given the opportunity to participate in a CGI summer workshop on CGI strategies during distance learning.
- School-wide 1:1 Chromebooks - All 138th Street School students have access to a device.
- Project Lead the Way (PLTW) - Utilize PLTW to provide an engaging, hands-on classroom lessons in computer science, engineering, and or biomedical science designed to empower students.
- Students will have access to a variety of enrichment activities that support student engagement, wellness and participation.
