

Safety


Anza school will ensure equitable conditions of learning for all students through safe and secure campuses, access to highly qualified teachers and required materials, as well as programs and resources to ensure their social-emotional wellbeing.


- Custodial staff will complete daily/weekly/monthly tasks as outlined in district-approved job descriptions. Custodial staff, district maintenance crew, and office staff will consult regularly to address facility issues and concerns.
- 100% of teachers will be fully credentialed and appropriately assigned as measured by human resources assignment monitoring reports. We will continue to ensure all teachers are credentialed properly for their assigned positions and receiving the necessary training required. Site administration will help maintain an equitable condition of learning for all students and assist with maintaining a safe and secure campus.
- We will continue to provide instructional materials to all students as reported in the SARC report.
- Anza staff and students will be provided the necessary personal protection equipment (PPE) on an as-needed basis and will
 follow up to date safety protocols provided by the LA County Department of Public Health. Anza administrators will work in
 conjunction with the district compliance team to ensure that all safety protocols are being followed.

Student-Centered





- School-wide implementation of the Accelerated Reader Program Students are provided with approximately 60 minutes a week of sustained silent reading as supported by AR testing and library check out of AR leveled books.
- Provide targeted intervention for identified students The intervention team and grade level teams will recommend students for intervention using AR STAR, CAASPP, Literably, and other appropriate screeners.
- Targeted resources Targeted resources are used with identified students to promote differentiated instruction within the school day. Classified intervention aide supports students in a variety of classroom settings to access core curriculum.
- Designated support for English Language Learners Credentialed and classified staff provide before and after school intervention to identified students based on ELPAC and CAASPP results.
- Music and Art Enrichment Students will have access to a variety of enrichment activities that support student engagement, wellness, and participation.
- Physical Education Students participate in PE classes 100 min. weekly.
- Counseling Support The CARE Team, implements strategies on a three tier level to meet the needs of our student's social
 emotional needs.
- Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS) Continue to implement a school-wide Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS) system to encourage positive behavior across school settings.
- Student Attendance Review Team (SART) SART and/or DART meetings will be held with families of students accruing 10
 or more unexcused absences or tardies.
- The school will provide opportunities for students to engage socially in a nonacademic settings. Some examples for student engagement opportunities are lunch bunch, social groups, and game days.

Future-Ready



Anza school will ensure that students are equipped for future success by focusing on collaboration, critical thinking, problem-solving, and creativity across all curricular areas, while also nurturing student growth as confident, resilient learners, and responsible citizens.

- Cognitive Guided Instruction Students have an intuitive understanding of math.
- Schoolwide implementation of ST Math All students have access to ST Math at school with the option to use it off-campus.
- Science and STEM Teacher on Special Assignment (TOSA) -The TOSA is providing instructional support to students through co-teaching and modeling with the classroom teacher.
- Schoolwide 1:1 Devices All Anza students have devices and have access to any time/anywhere to learning.
- Project Lead the Way (PLTW) Utilize PTLW to provide engaging, hands-on classroom lessons in computer science, engineering, and or biomedical science designed to empower students.
- Scholastic Readers Elementary level media that provides information and activities based on current events, holidays, and new research with a focus on science and social studies.





Community and Collaboration

Anza school will increase family and community involvement in school activities and decisions and ensure regular communication with families through multiple formats.

- Parent Education Nights Anza staff will host parent nights that will help build community and increase parent understanding of the curriculum.
- Anza will introduce a program entitled, WATCH D.O.G.S WATCH D.O.G.S., one of the nation's largest and most respected school-based, family, and community engagement, organizations.
- The principal will send out a weekly update via e-mail.
- The school website will be live and updated as needed.
- Social media will be utilized to highlight and remind families of school events.
- All printed school communication will be provided in both English and Spanish.
- Translators will be available for caregivers upon request.





Organizational Strength

Anza school will regularly evaluate and manage organization procedures and practices in order to maintain a strong fiscal position in support of advancing school site goals.

- Maintaining an ongoing spreadsheet to log and track ongoing expenditures, in collaboration with front office staff.
