Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our Lord is risen! The Light of the world has conquered the darkness and provided for us the opportunity for life with him, now and forever. After a long, challenging year, we now joyfully celebrate the Lord's Resurrection and are renewed and strengthened by the hope he imparts.

I pray that each of you is able to embrace fully this sacred season of Our Lord's victory over suffering and death. Despite the pandemic and the other difficulties brought into our lives over the past year, we have reason to rejoice! Our Lord loves us and, in faithful obedience to the Father, offered the ultimate sacrifice on our behalf, so that we might have eternal life with him in heaven with the saints and the angels.

At the start of Lent, on Ash Wednesday, I preached about a fundamental virtue for those pursuing a close relationship with God: humility. St. Augustine famously wrote, "If you should ask me what are the ways of God, I would tell you that the first is humility, the second is humility, and the third is humility. Not that there are no other precepts to give, but if humility does not precede all that we do, our efforts are fruitless." God alone has the power to conquer death and give new life in him. Our joy should be rooted in humbly acknowledging that the salvation won by Christ is freely offered to us. Death and resurrection are gifts freely offered, and we must rely upon his infinite mercy to enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

In our lives, we experience happiness as well as sorrow, and if we unite our joys and sufferings to Christ's, he will lead us to share in his victory and the glory of his Resurrection. Thus, may we celebrate the blessings of Easter with a humble and grateful heart!

May the peace of the risen Lord, the Light of the world, be with you in this Easter season and always.

EXTENSIONS FOR INCOME TAX FILING – Recently, the federal government announced an extension for filing income tax returns, the new date being May 17, 2021. Virginia Governor Northam followed suit a few days later, setting the new date as May 17 to align it with the federal extended deadline for filing tax returns. Please note that the AARP Tax-Aide office, located in Vienna Trust Bank (formerly SunTrust), 515 Maple Ave. E will remain open through May 17. Please refer to the March 21 Bulletin for days they're open, as well as the hours and other important information.

GET WOWBRARY – This is a nonprofit service that sends you <u>free</u> weekly e-mails featuring your library's most recent acquisitions. Wowbrary was started by some folks who were thrilled when they saw all the wonderful new books, DVDs, and CDs their library acquired each week, and they wanted everyone to discover how great their library is too. If you love reading, you'll enjoy hearing about the newest books, movies, and music in the Fairfax County Library system. To get going, visit <u>newest@wowbrary.org</u>. Your privacy is protected and not shared with anyone. I've been using it for years and appreciate the many features it offers. For instance, you can read reviews of the item you're interested in, and with a click, you'll be able to put it on hold at the library of your choice.

NEW PIN FOR TAXPAYER SECURITY – Tax filers can now get a six-digit personal ID number from the IRS that's designed to add a layer of security and prevent identity theft. It will protect you if someone gains access to your Social Security number and attempts to use it to file a bogus return and fraudulently obtain a refund. But be careful: if you file electronically and forget your PIN, the IRS may reject your tax return. To obtain an identity protection PIN, visit irs.gov/identity-theft-fraud-scams/get-an-identityprotection-pin.
