Dear Families,

By the 12th April, many of the shops will have re-opened and we would be grateful if you could support us in maintaining our high standards by purchasing any further items needed to ensure that your children are in full school uniform.

Before your child returns to school after Easter please ensure that:

All nail varnish is removed before they come to school.

If ears are pierced, that there is only one earring in each ear in the lowest ear lobe. There should be no additional piercings. Please do not allow your child to have any new piercings over the Easter break as their skin will not have time to heal and these will have to be removed for PE and Dance.

Your child has their natural hair colour.

Your child wears the full Sydenham PE kit only on the days they have PE. Students should only wear the Sydenham leggings or Sydenham tracksuit bottoms. The only hoodies that can be worn with the PE kit are Sydenham hoodies.

Sydenham blazers are worn by students in Years 7-10.

As of Monday 19 April, any uniform infringement will be sanctioned according to our Behaviour Policy and the item may be confiscated in line with our policy.
