

# Fellowship for Teachers of Color



**Carroll School trains teachers.** In an effort to address the greatest need of each child, we recognize that diversity and inclusivity are essential to a child’s learning experience, as are great teachers. That’s why we’ve established The Fellowship for Teachers of Color in the Angela Wilkins Program of Graduate Studies in Education.

## About the Fellowship

The fellowship provides two full scholarships for teachers of color for a collaborative masters degree and licensure program in Moderate Disabilities PreK-8 & 5-12 with Lesley University, a 14-month intensive residency-based graduate program.

Two chosen candidates receive a \$25,000 scholarship for courses taken at Lesley and forgives the cost of courses taken at Carroll School, including free Orton-Gillingham training and certification.

## Candidate Requirements:

1. Completed undergraduate degree.
