It is our hope that your online registration will be done prior to May 7th. If you do not have a computer, you may go to the district registrar's office before May 7th and use one of the computers there. Call ahead to check availability at 719-391-3011. Once your online registration is complete, you may drop by Central Registration to finish the enrollment process and turn in required paperwork (birth certificate, immunization records, and proof of residence). These must be turned in BEFORE your student can start school. Central registration is located in the S.A. Wilson building at 930 Leta Dr, Colo Spgs, CO 80911.
