

Important Update - 4/5/21 - Learning Schedule This Week

Dear DCS Families, Students, and Staff,

Thank you for your patience as we work through a quick adjustment for the week in response to the rapid increases in Covid-19 cases in the community, the county, and the state. **Our team just met and we believe we can safely provide inperson instruction this week with the changes outlined below.** In order to continue with in-person instruction, we need your help and diligence in preventing further spread of Covid-19. Please be extremely cautious and committed to helping us protect each other so we can have our kids safely in school.

Starting Tuesday, April 6th:

- Anchor/Beacon/Wylie Homeroom students will attend daily as originally scheduled this week.
- Creekside Homeroom students will attend on the A/B schedule the rest of the week with B group students on Tuesday/Friday and A group students on Wednesday/Thursday. Start and end times will be the same as prior to spring break. Non-in-person days will continue to be asynchronous days for A or B group students. The reason Creekside is making this change is because the 10-17 year old age group is the largest growing group of cases in the state. <u>Starting Monday (4/12)</u>, Homeroom students will move back to the 5 day per week in-person schedule that started prior to spring break.
- Mill Creek HomeROOM & HomeBASED students will attend on the A/B schedule the rest of the week:
 - B-day students report on Tuesday 4/6 & Friday 4/9
 - A-day students report on Wednesday 4/7 & Thursday 4/8.
 - HomeBASED students follow team HomeBASED schedule
 - Start and end times will be the same as prior to spring break.
 - Non-in-person days will continue to be asynchronous days for A or B group students.
 - <u>Starting Monday (4/12), HomeROOM students will move to the 4 day per week in-person</u> schedule and <u>HomeBASED to 4 days of instruction that was originally scheduled to begin today</u>.
- Dexter High School homeroom students will attend on an A/B schedule the rest of the week:
 - B-day students on Tuesday, 4/6 & Friday, 4/9
 - A-day students on Wednesday, 4/7 & Thursday, 4/8
 - Start and end times will be the same as prior to spring break.
 - On remote days, students will zoom into classes.
 - The schedule for the week of April 12th will follow the SAT/PSAT/MStep testing schedule.

We ask that all parents continue to conduct the daily health screener with your child before school (daily). If your child has any symptoms, please keep your child home. We also are requesting that families please notify hr@dexterschools.org if your child or a family member have recently tested positive for Covid-19 or are currently in quarantine.

Thank you for your patience and understanding.
