As most of you know, April 10<sup>th</sup> marks the date for the statewide mask mandate. With this date looming ahead, there is still a lot of confusion about mask requirements. While the statewide mast requirements end for MOST public places, the mask requirements for K-12 schools REMAINS IN PLACE until June 15. Local officials, (like school boards or county councils, or even school principals do NOT have legal authority to end the school mask requirement before June 15. In addition, Mask requirements will remain in place for group gatherings of 50 or more people until July 1. Attached to this newsletter is a list of reasons Public Health officials and the Legislature gave for continuing the mask mandate in schools. It is my hope that our community, our parents and our students will continue to support our efforts in educating children and support the decisions made by our legislators and leaders. Please help us finish this school year strong with masks on.

In other news, we held our school-wide spelling bee a few weeks ago, and three of our top spellers were invited to the semi-final District spelling-bee. One of our school's spellers, Brady Evans made it through the semi-final competition and will progress to the Final District Spelling Bee on April 22<sup>nd</sup>.
