Counseling Report- (Mr. Plant)

- Things are continuing to move forward.

Student Report (Kate Woods)

- Spirit week will be held at the end of year. Each day the SBO's will center around a different activity and provide a CJH bracelet to each student.
- Possibly doing a virtual talent show

Trust Land Updates-Mr. Stromberg (Carryover)

- 2020-2021 has been a complicated year with COVID. Some of our programs haven't been implemented due to COVID, causing an excess in trust land funds.
- These excess funds could possibly be used in technology updates, adding an additional Study Skill class and replacing outdated projectors. Mr. Stromberg and Ms. Dimond are looking at individual classrooms for technology updates.
- Teachers now have net support to allow teachers to see what students are viewing on their individual computers.
- Each student received a \$2.00 incentive. There is a remainder of \$1000.00 to use by end of year and will assist SBO's with the purchase of bracelets.
- The carryover amount for next year will be approximately \$12,000-\$15,000.00.

Report

Review and Vote on 2021-2022 School Improvement Plan

- Goals continued to be the same as previous school year (2020-2021)

- An electronic vote will also be sent via Mr. Stromberg.

The weekly newsletter also includes the SEL theme. Suggestion was made to add a prompt question in the weekly newsletter to have dialogue between parent and student.
